<i>Bursera simarouba</i>	gumbo limbo	Living fence
<i>Coccoloba uvifera</i>	sea grape	Fruit
<i>Diospyros virginiana</i>	American persimmon	Fruit
<i>Eugenia axillaris</i>	white stopper	Fruit
<i>Lysiloma latisiliquum</i>	wild tamarind	Nitrogen, hammock pioneer
<i>Myrcianthes fragrans</i>	Simpson's stopper	Fruit
<i>Piscidia piscipula</i>	Florida fishpoison	Nitrogen
<i>Sapindus saponaria</i>	soapberry	Fruit for soap

SHRUBS

There are a bunch of native edible columnar fruiting cacti to play with as well.

<i>Acacia choriophylla</i>	cinnecord	Nitrogen
<i>Acacia pinetorum</i>	pineland acacia	Nitrogen
<i>Chrysobalanus icaco</i>	cocoplum	Fruit
<i>Erythrina herbacea</i>	red cardinal	Nitrogen
<i>Myrica cerifera</i>	wax myrtle	Nitrogen
<i>Pithecellobium keyense</i>	Keys blackbead	Nitrogen
<i>Sophora tomentosa</i>	yellow necklacepod	Nitrogen
<i>Vaccinium myrcinites</i>	shiny blueberry	Fruit

VINES

<i>Apios americana</i>	groundnut	Tubers, nitrogen
<i>Aster carolinianus</i>	climbing aster	Insect nectary
<i>Cucurbita moschata</i> *	Seminole pumpkin	Fruit, seeds, greens
<i>Passiflora incarnata</i>	maypop	fruit
<i>Trichostigma octandrum</i>	Haitian basket vine	greens
<i>Vitis rotundifolia</i>	muscadine	Fruit

* Not really native.

HERBS

Many native Aster, Mint, and Umbel family nectaries could be added, especially shade-loving species.

<i>Capsicum annum glabriosellum</i>	bird pepper	Spicy peppers
<i>Capsicum frutescens</i>	Tabasco pepper	Spicy peppers
<i>Cnidocolus stimulosus</i>	Tread-softly	Tubers
<i>Helianthus debilis</i>	beach sunflower	Insect nectary
<i>Solanum americanum</i>	black nightshade	Greens, fruit
<i>Solidago odora</i>	sweet goldenrod	Tea, insect nectary
<i>Tripsacum dactyloides</i>	Fakahatchee grass	Mulch

GROUNDCOVERS

<i>Blechnum serrulatum</i>	swamp fern	Groundcover
<i>Calyptocarpus vialis</i>	straggler daisy	Insect nectary, groundcover
<i>Canavalia rosea</i>	beach bean	Nitrogen, groundcover
<i>Crotolaria rotundifolia</i>	rabbitbells	Nitrogen, groundcover
<i>Hydrocotyle umbelata</i>	water pennywort	Insect nectary, groundcover
<i>Mimosa strigillosa</i>	powderpuff, sunshine mimosa	Nitrogen, groundcover
<i>Peperomia obtusifolia</i>	baby pepperplant	Groundcover
<i>Sesuvium portulacastrum</i>	sea purslane	Greens, groundcover
<i>Stachys floridana</i>	Florida hedgenettle	Tubers, groundcover
<i>Stylosanthes spp.</i>	pencil-flower	Nitrogen, groundcover
<i>Woodwardia virginica</i>	Virginia chain fern	Groundcover
<i>Zamia pumila</i>	coontie	Starch/toxic roots, groundcover, fixes some nitrogen!
